THE MOST IMPORTANT SPACE AT HOME

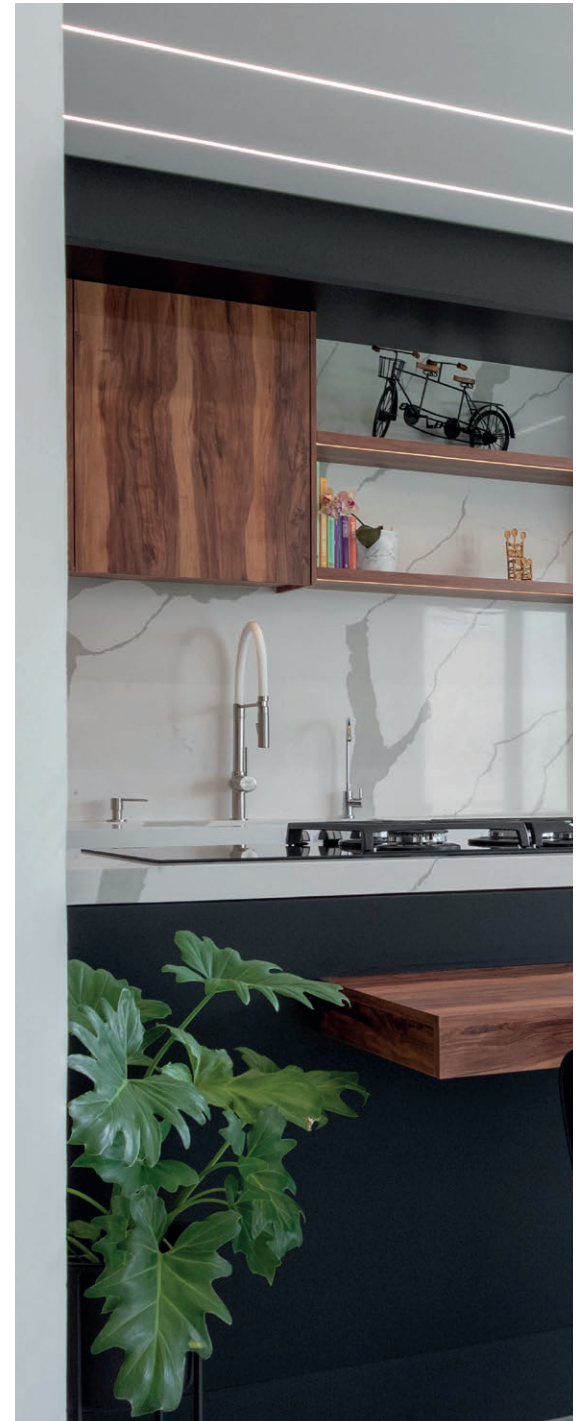
The kitchen has become one of the most important spaces inside the house, this is the place where we focus most of the activities of interaction and much more than cooking.

Over time, the space designated for the kitchen, living room and dining room has had several transformations as a result of the way we used them.



























THE MOST IMPORTANT SPACE AT HOME

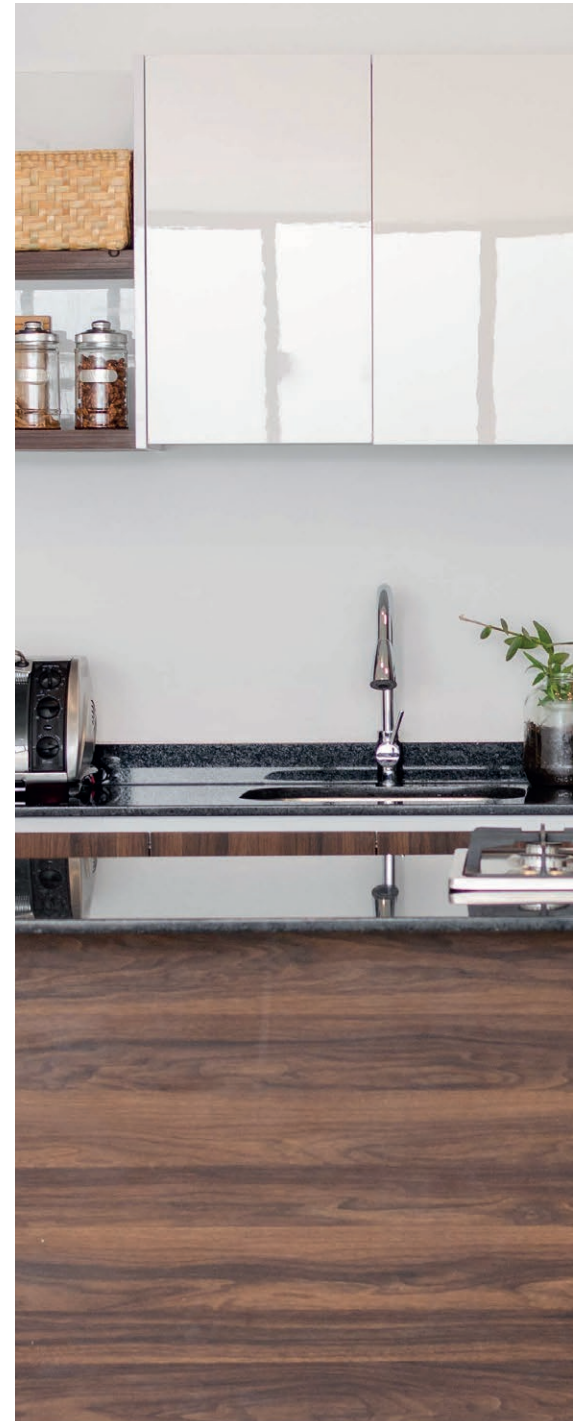
Currently the dining room has become a place without use in response to the trend of apartment towers and reduced spaces giving priority to social spaces like the kitchen where most of the interaction activities are centered.

Over years of experience, we have become more conscious about the importance and the value that has been acquired by this space therefore it is indispensable to make a good choice of materials, textures and design.











Materials

The use of MDF (medium density fiberboard), MDP (Medium density particleboard) or Laminates guarantee major durability, resistance to water exposure and resistance to thin scratches so we used them consistently in our furniture proposals to create spaces for high use but low maintenance.

High gloss and super matte laminates are used for doors or front parts of the cabinets. On the other hand, veneers give a much warmer and homely feature of lacquered cabinets (paint process) to solid surfaces.



Sensations through textures and design

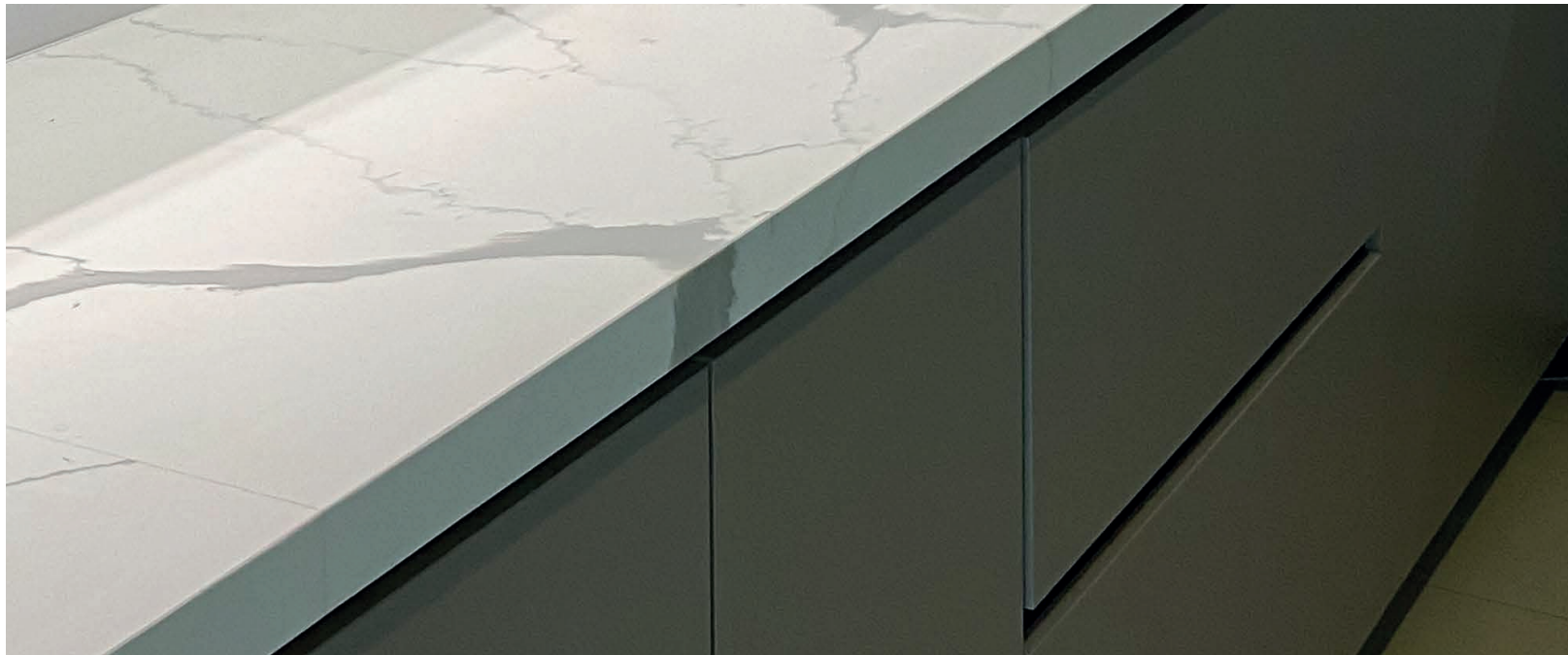
Quartz, solid surfaces, natural and synthetic stones are the most common textures in our countertop proposals giving touches of vanguard and aesthetic appearance. Also we like to include touches of warm lighting to highlight materials and design by giving the space a much more innovative and homily sensations.



Design

Functionality is one of the basic principles of design. It is one of the first aspects to value when we talk about the space that will be designated to place the kitchen in the house. We have to evaluate the logical distribution of spaces, connectivity, hallways, equipment storage areas, home appliances and materials.

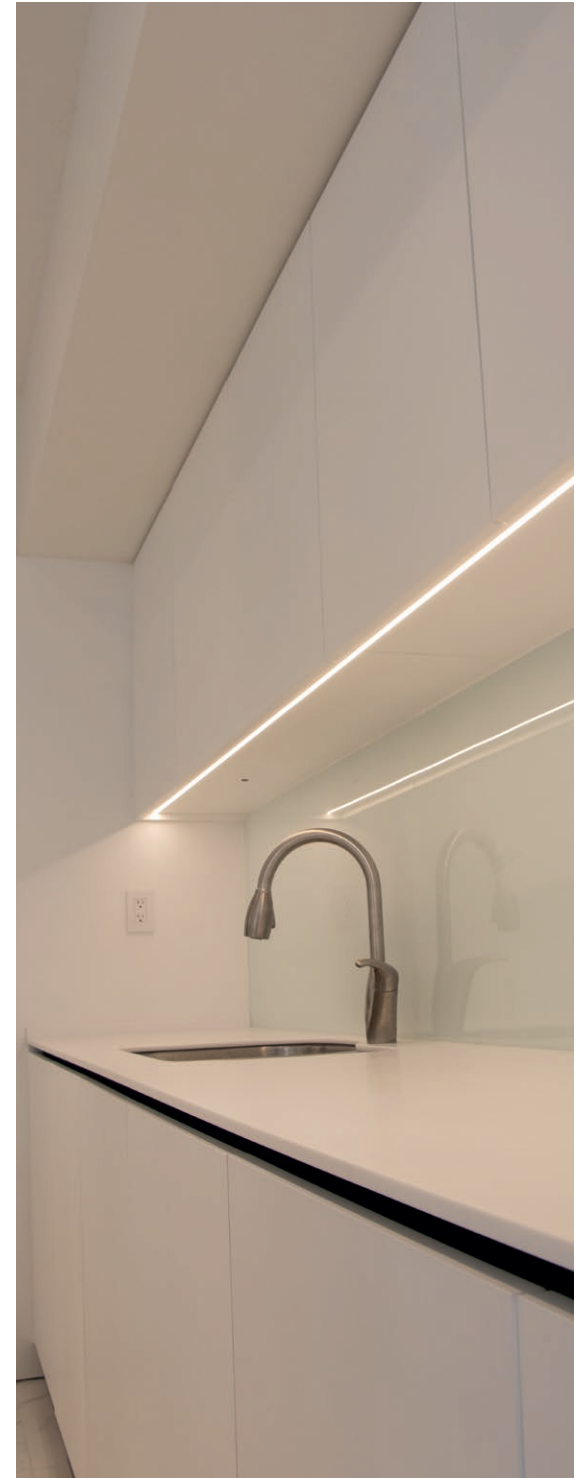
Symmetry and homogeneity give us aspects of simplicity, harmony that hardly go out of style.















WARM MINIMALISM.

Alluding to the famous quote of Mies Van Der Rohe, one of the most important architects and pioneers of modernist architecture, “less is more”, it arrives with warm minimalism. The ornamentation in architecture is a thing of the past. Nowadays it has more important elements for simple and organized options, likewise interior design leans for simplicity, neutral colors and natural materials that are in trend.



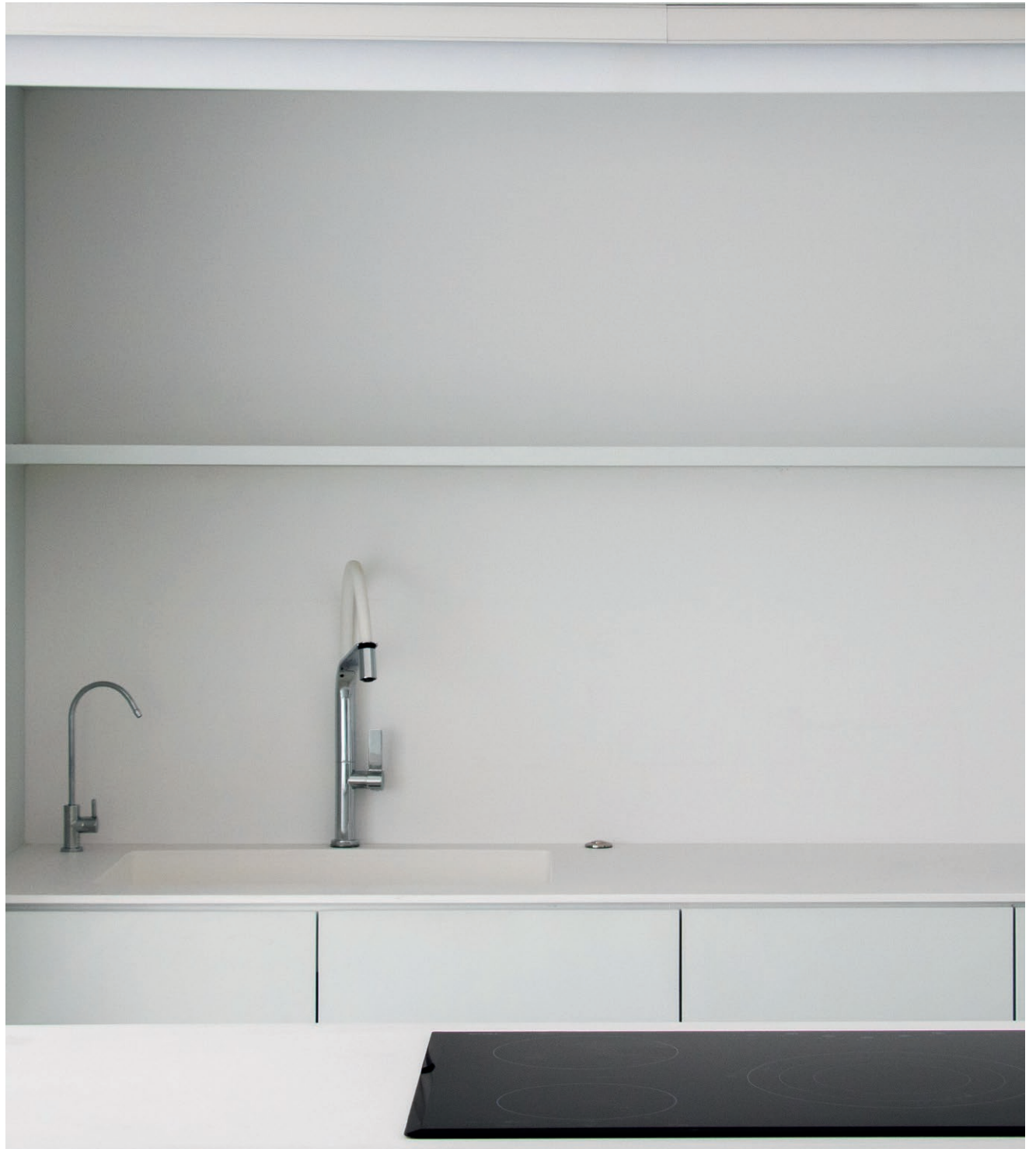














WARM MINIMALISM.

The essentials.

Simplicity prevails on spaces in formal composition of furniture and interior decoration. Disappearing the unnecessary elements helps to maintain the order and the functionality while emphasizing the clean esthetic and the decor elements to make relaxed and authentic spaces linked to Nordic styles, minimalism and boho style that trend in interior design.

Neutral colors.

Commonly we associate white color with minimalism. The term minimalist style is more deep and specific than using only this color, it exhorts us to create comfy atmospheres with the range of colors like ocher, beige and brown accompanied by small touches of vibrant colors to generate contrasts and dynamic sensations.

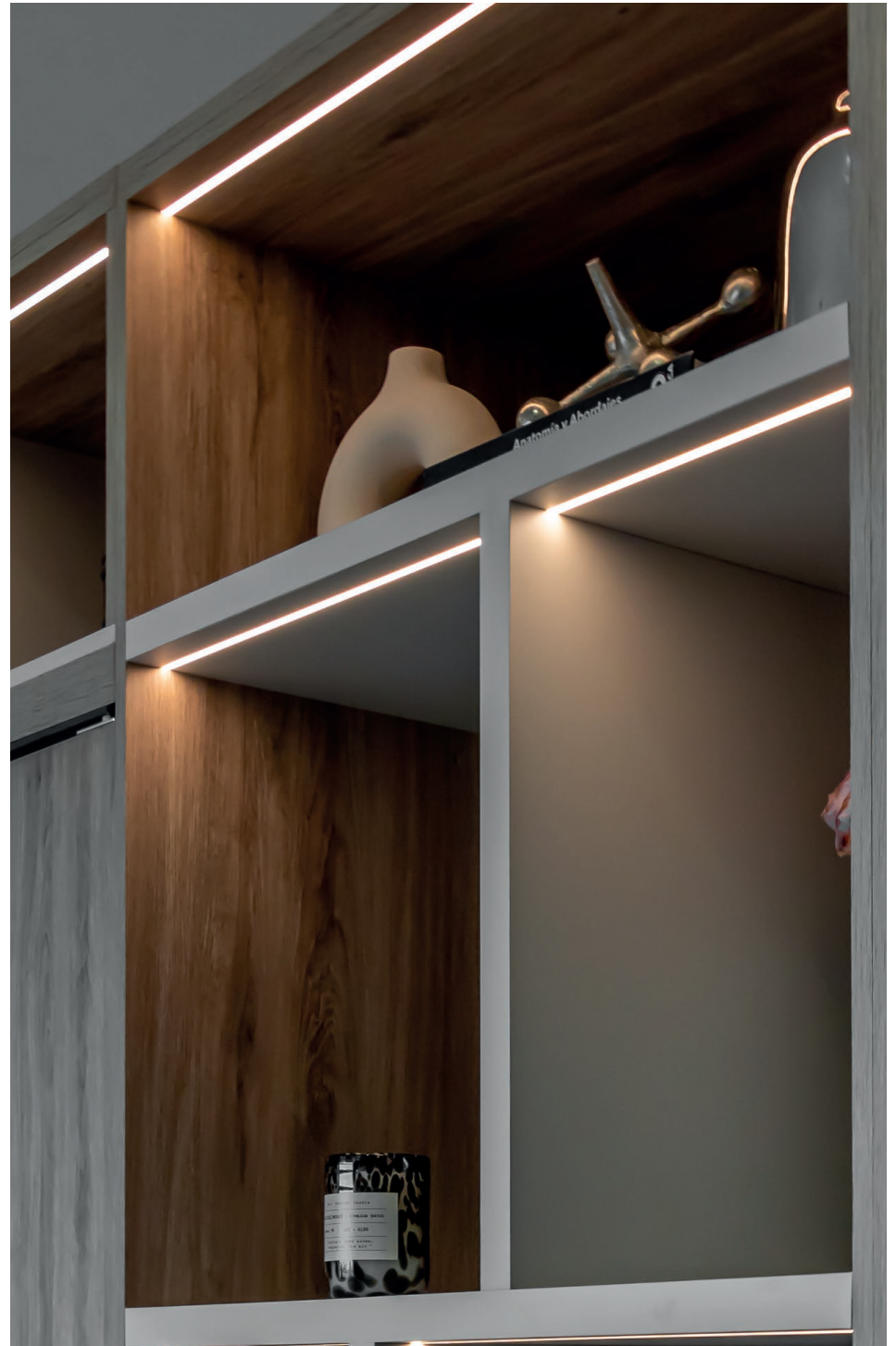
Wood laminates have become one of the vital elements for interior designs, especially; light colors, neutral colors and matte textures, that give comfy and relaxed sensations.





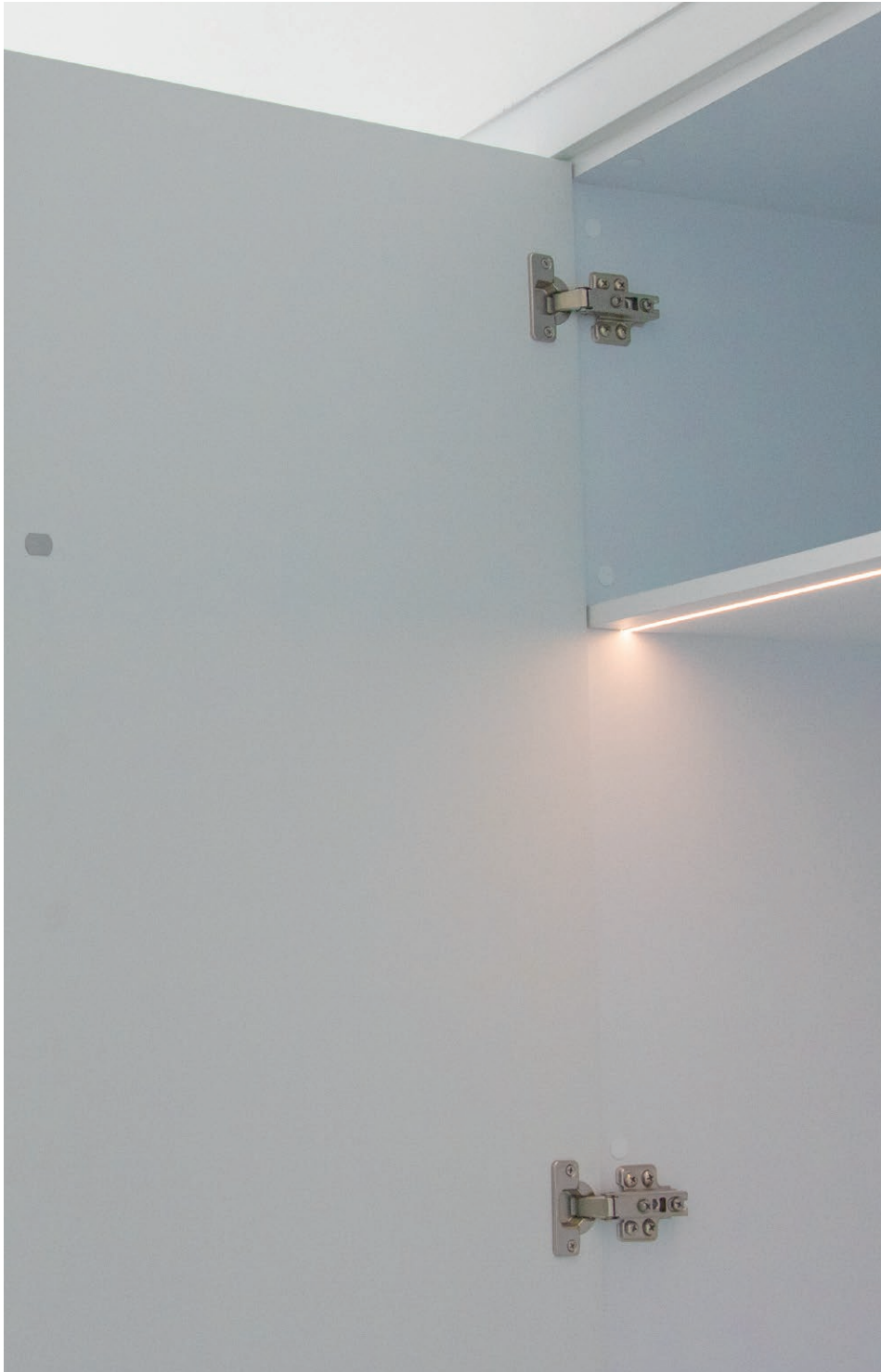








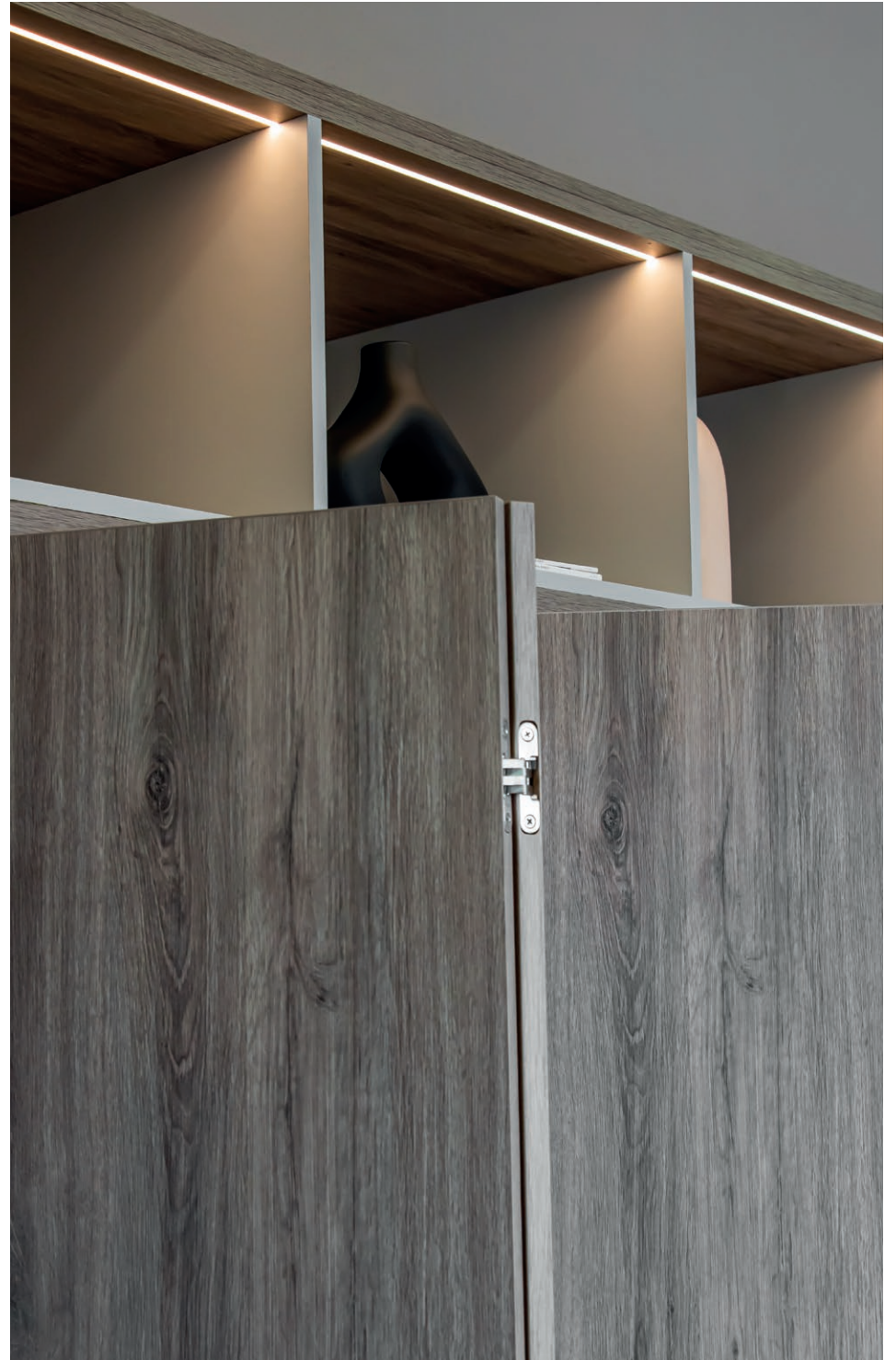












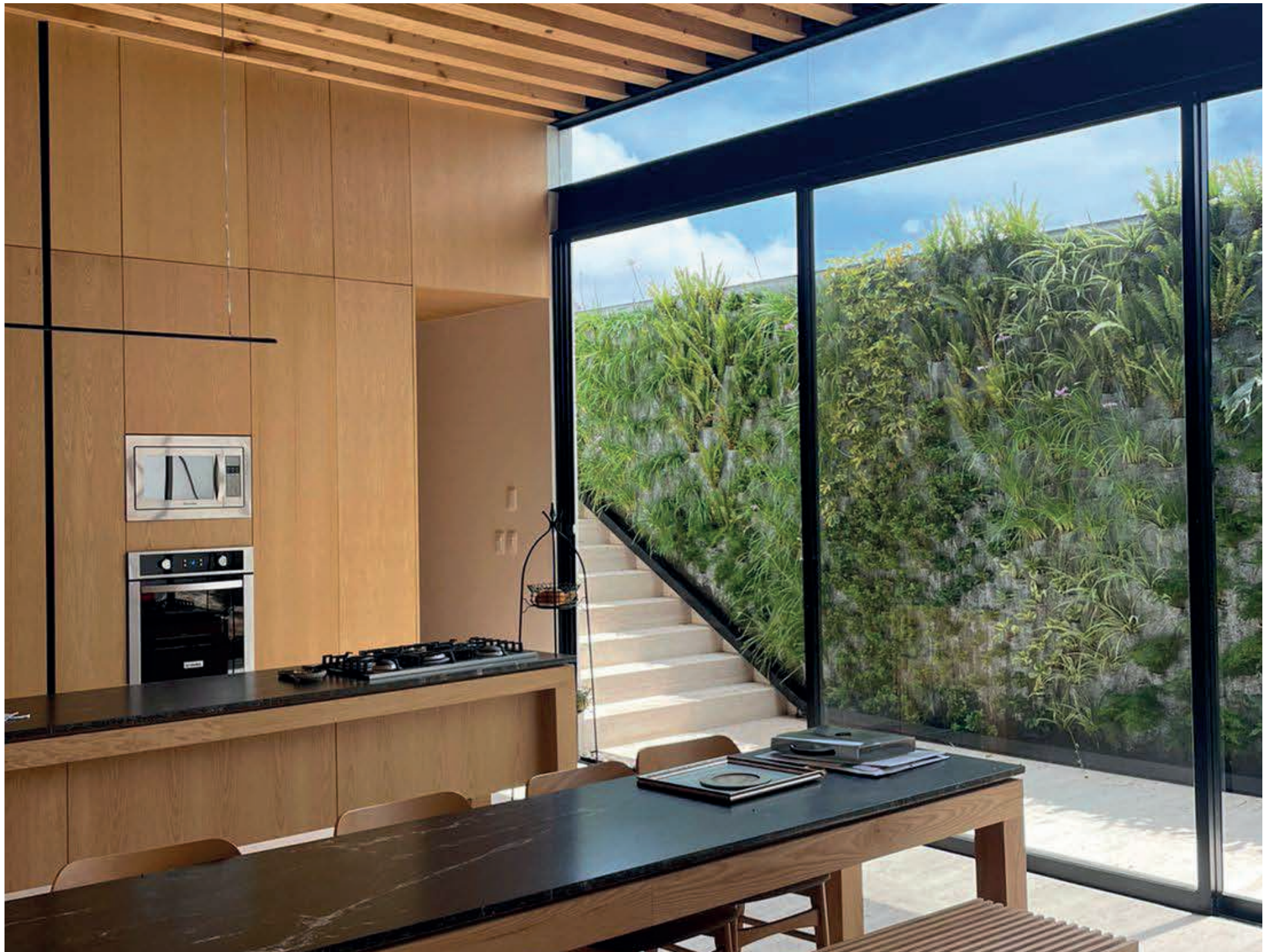
TREND OF NATURAL MATERIALS.

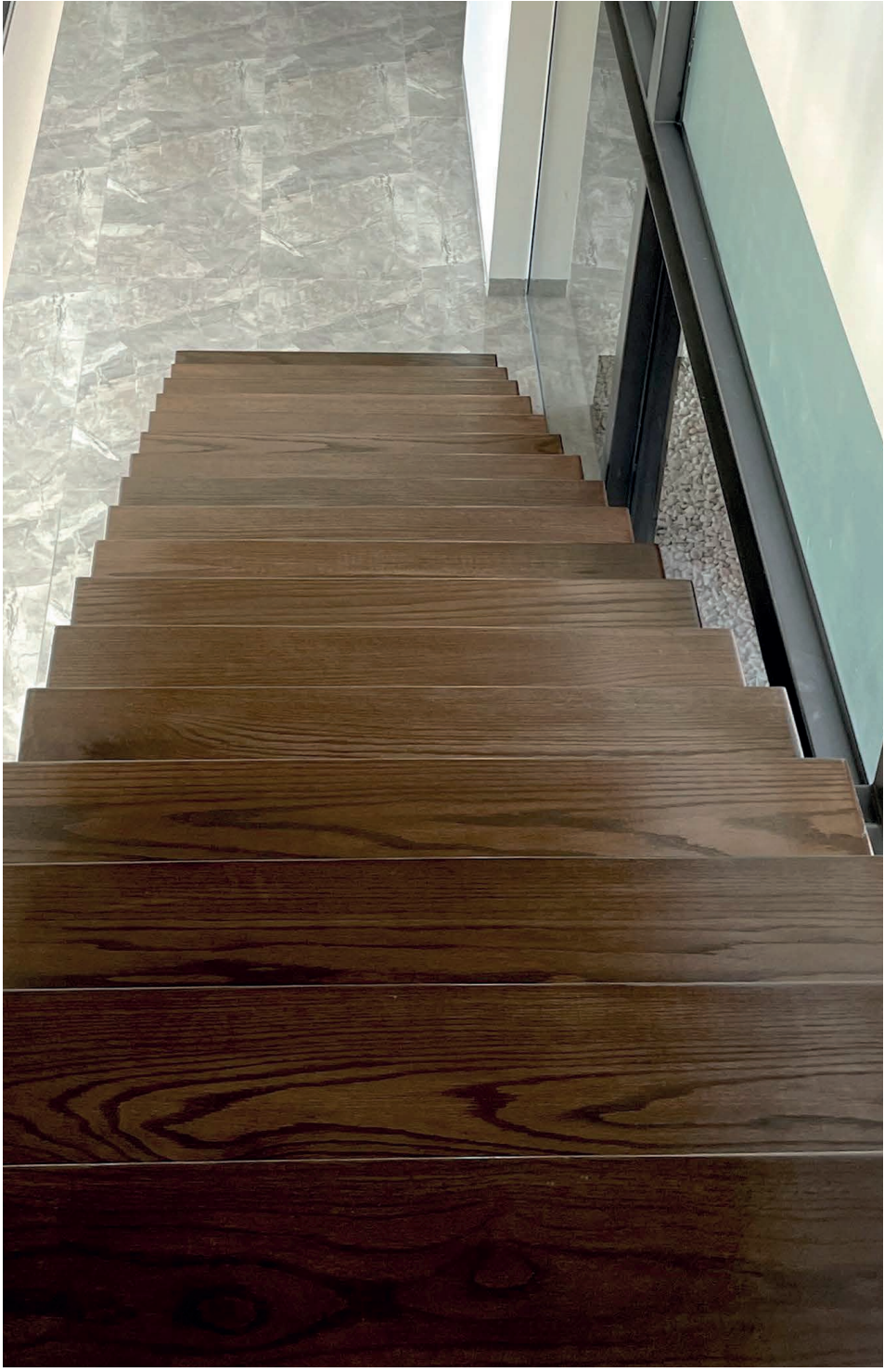
Environment is a theme of global interest. In order to counteract the industry impact and deforestation, Vori Vost encourages the use of materials that represent our compromise of reducing the environmental impact.

In response to this, materials that come from recycling have become stronger not only because of design trends or customer needs, but to transcend in other ways further than design and function approaches.

Nowadays wood is the material present in all interior and decor proposals because it gives timelessness characteristics, meaning that it will be always on trend and could be combined with a variety of concepts to design.

MDF (medium density fiberboard) that we use in Vori Vost have taken relevance in general by the furniture manufacturers because the materials are mostly manufactured at 80% by wood waste.



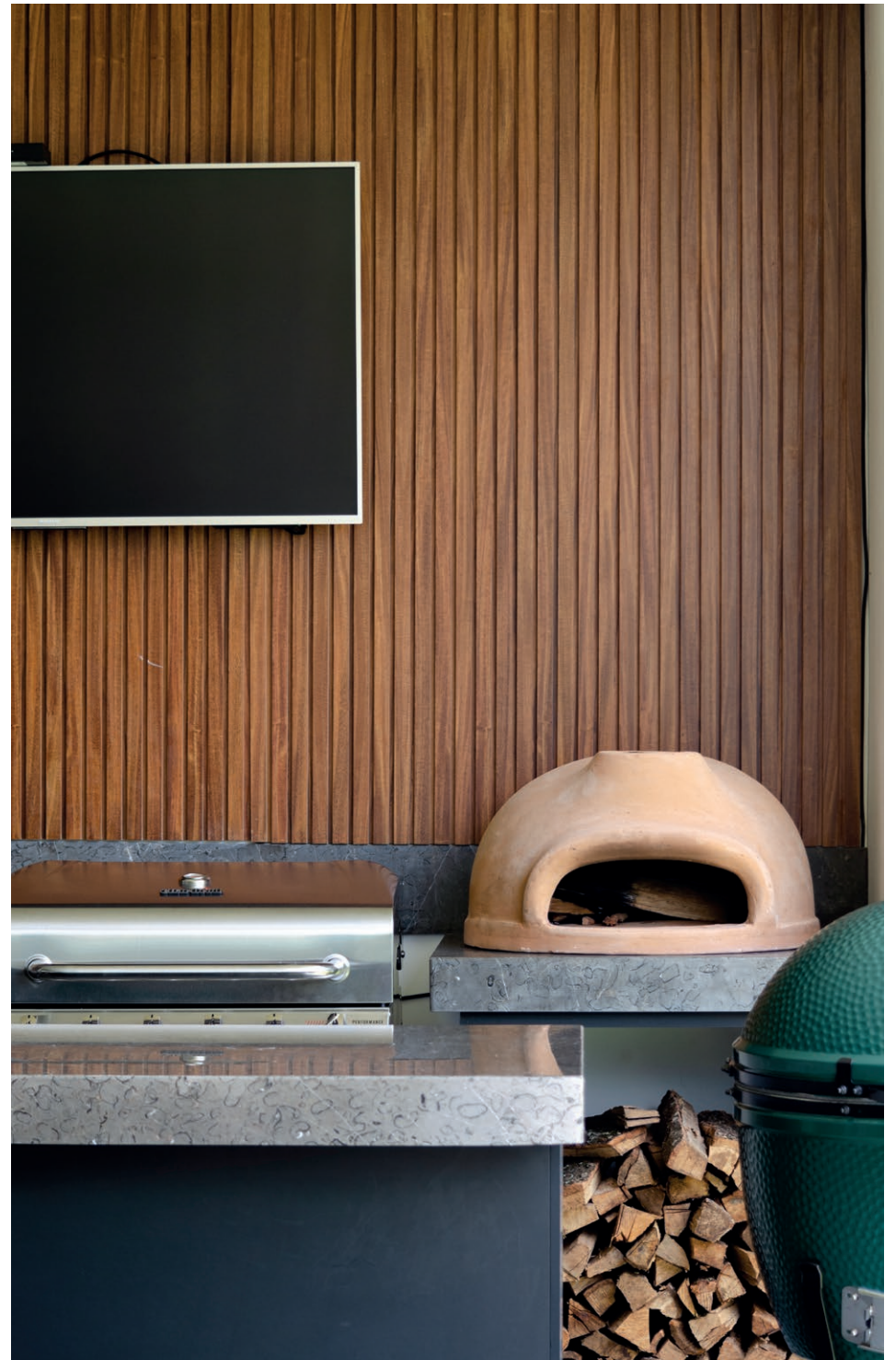


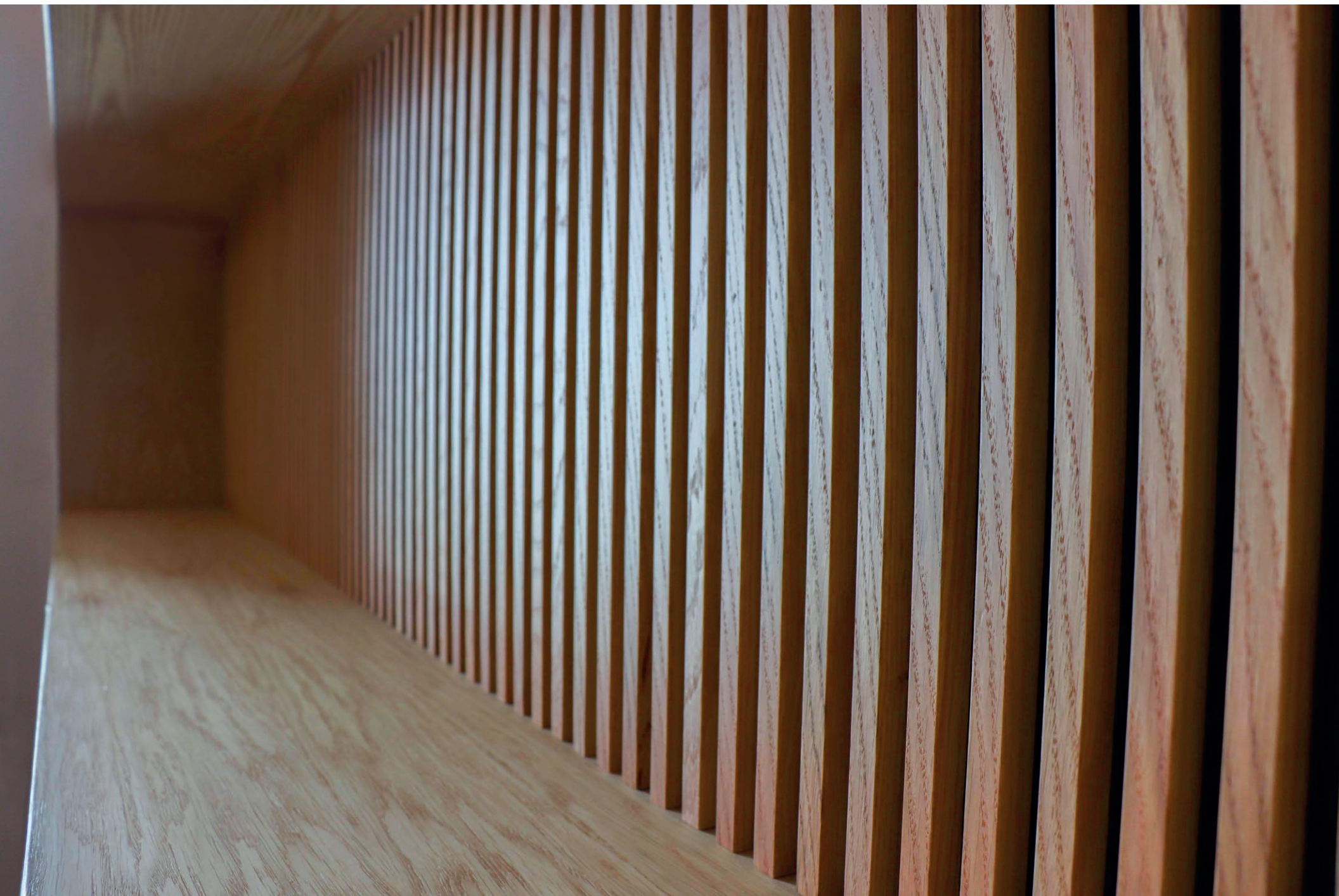


TREND OF NATURAL MATERIALS.

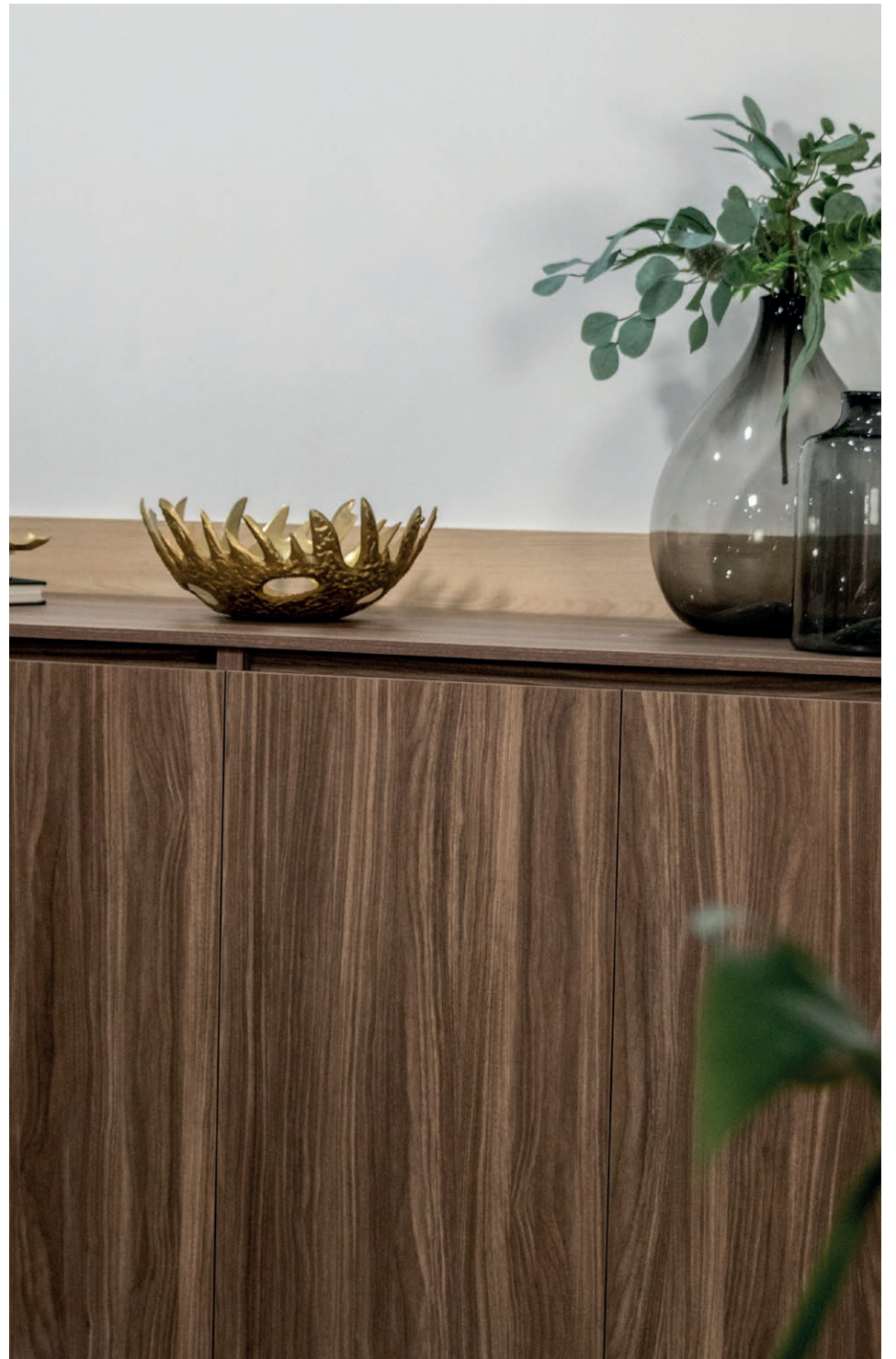
The boards are submitted to compact processes to obtain rigid and solid surfaces that are covered by plastic laminates or veneers giving important attributes like water resistance, textures and appearance to natural materials. Last but not least, our board's selection contributes to environmental care.











COLOR NOTES.

Achromatic and neutral colors are the basis of minimalist and boho styles, creating impeccable and aesthetic spaces. However, this does not mean that subtle notes of vibrant colors are not incorporated to achieve a balance in the design proposals.

Working with colors is an important resource for balance in interior design, not only to apply contrasts but also to understand that colors work together to highlight elements and create different environments and sensations.

The good application of color theory, can make small spaces wide and illuminate corners from very large and cold spaces to warm and homely spaces.







COLOR NOTES.

In Vori Vost designs, we follow 60/30/10 criteria when choosing colors. We recommend choosing no more than three colors at the time of design, where there must be a dominant color in terms of surface. Our criteria indicates that we must ensure that the neutral elements are those which represent 60% of the space, while 30 or 10% represent the vibrant color to give the project personality.

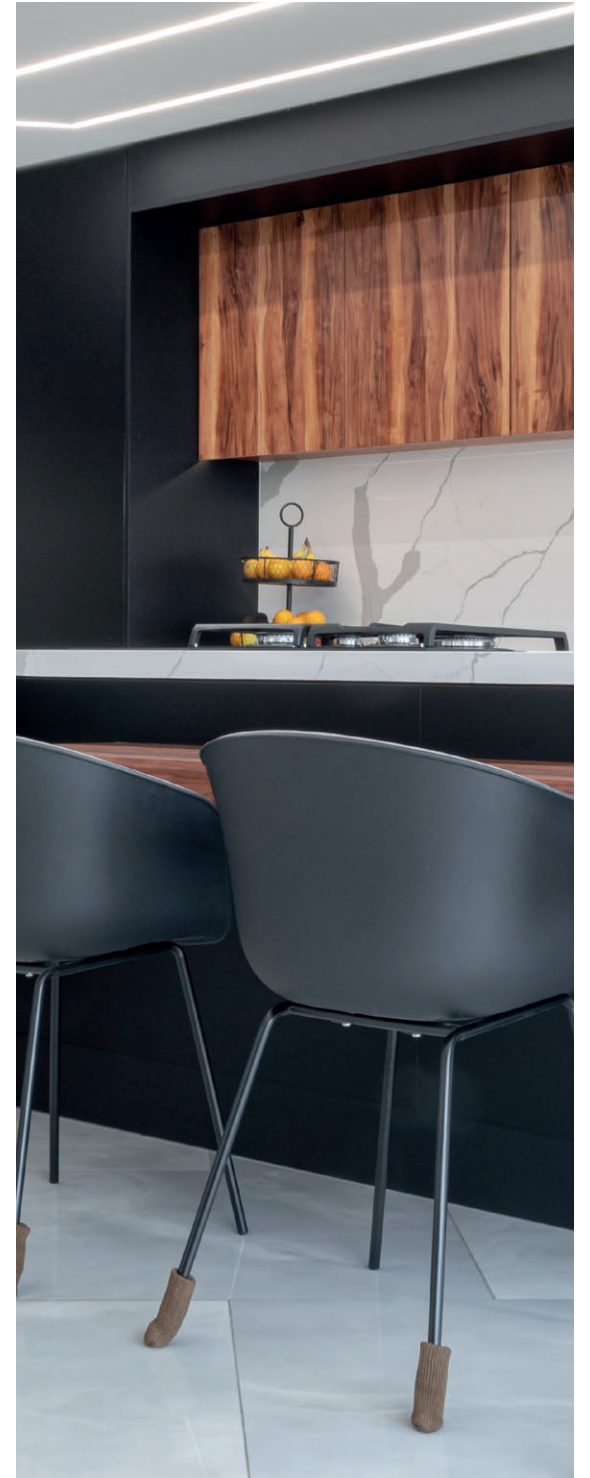
To exemplify and refer to the aforementioned criteria, the trend is as follows: neutral colors on walls and floors with 60% of the surface area, wood in natural tones with 30% designated for furniture; and a 10% with fine touches of color on some walls, decoration, tapestries, or textures of the furniture itself.

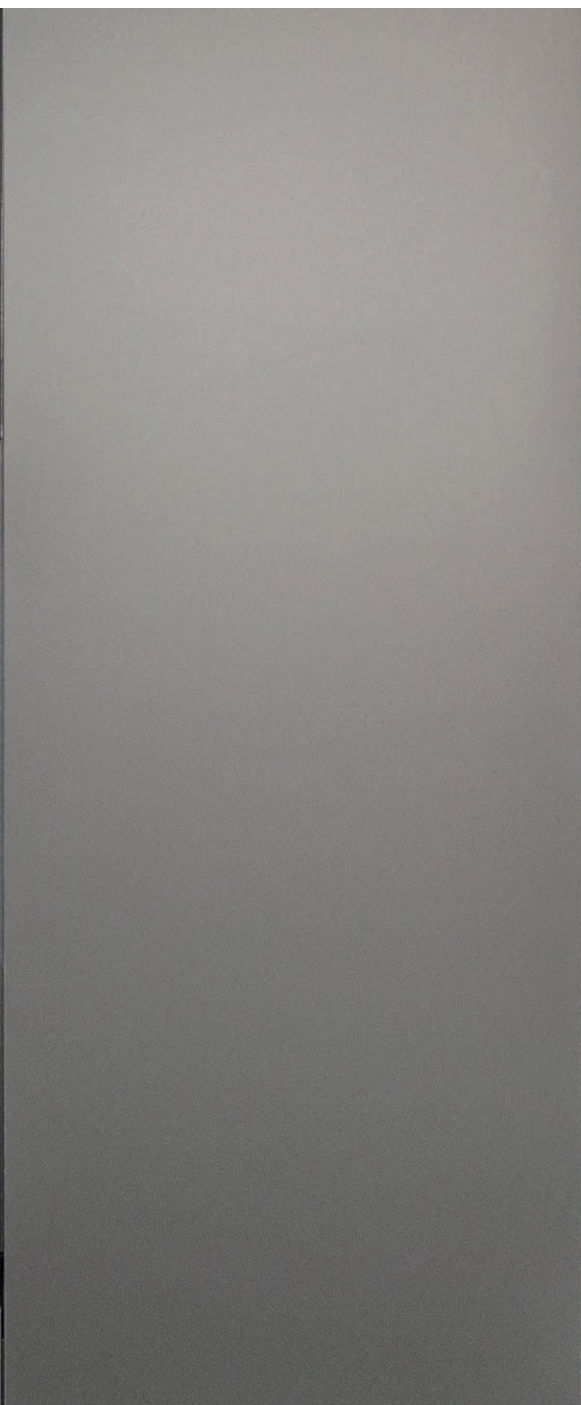








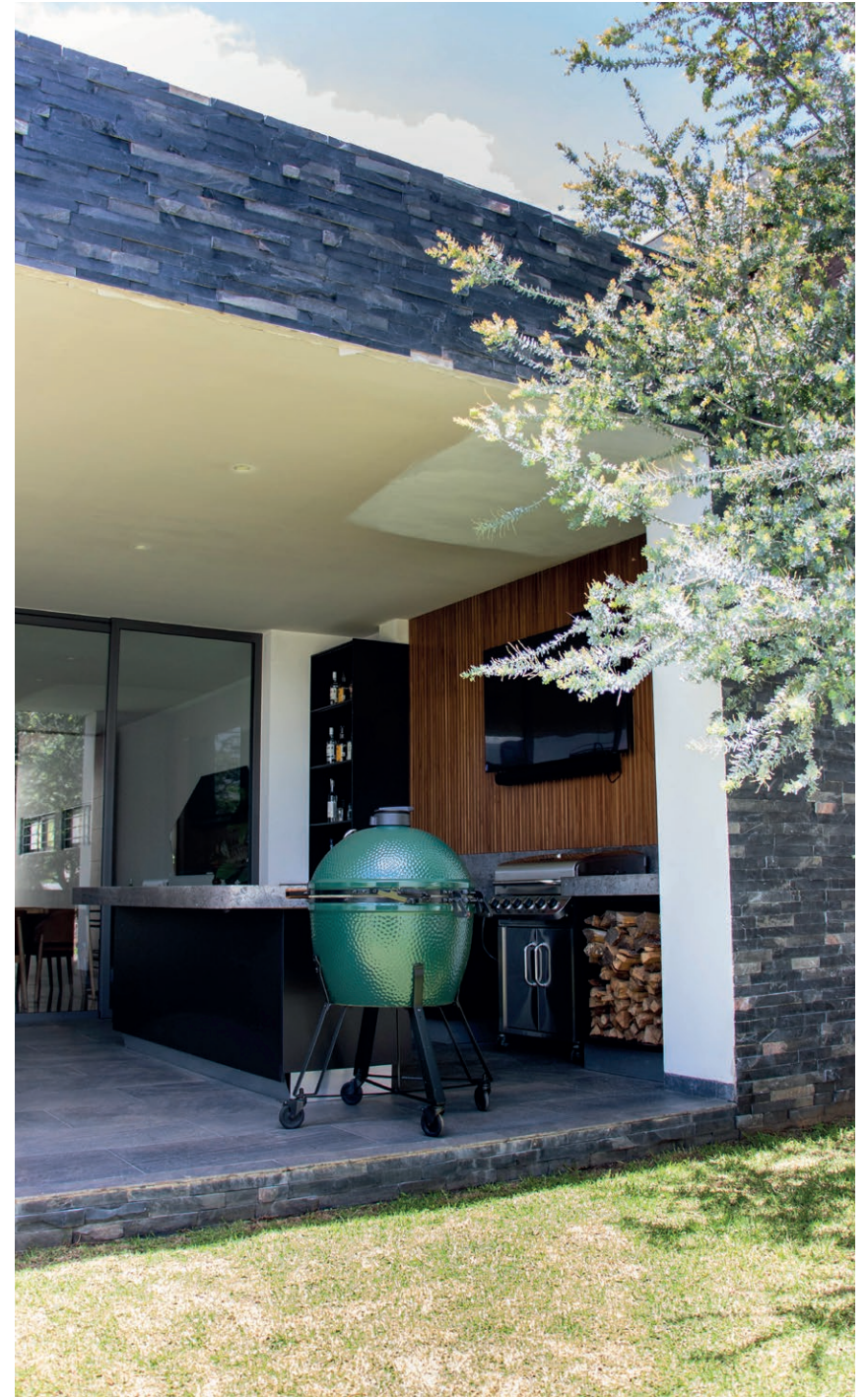






OUTDOOR SPACES.
